1 Objectives

The workshops are intended to provide a platform to enable 4E Members to share information on recent and prospective changes in scope, metrics, test methods and performance requirements amongst energy efficiency appliance and equipment policies to:

- Identify the differences between these policies in 4E Member countries/regions, and better understand the reasons for these.
- Identify opportunities for future collaborative research/investigations (bi-lateral or multi-lateral) that would lead to improved alignment.
- Track changes in the above elements to indicate the effort in policy updates, increases in stringency and identify any broad trends in policy development.
- Note whether policies are moving towards greater alignment.
